Progress Report on 2019-20 Projects

She would like ~\$5K in current funds to be reallocated to the project to pay Portland Parks & Recreation for ongoing maintenance work. Committee determined to add to the project list for 2020-21 as a reimbursement request.

The list of proposed projects and budget line items for 2020-21 was introduced for discussion.
